Notice - Procurement of Services by Area Agencies on Aging

The AAA is currently seeking qualified entities to provide services such as: Congregate Meals, Home Delivered Meals, Transportation, Adult Day Care, Personal Assistance, Homemaker, Health Maintenance, Emergency Response Services, Evidence Based Intervention Programming, and Caregiver Respite. Parties interested in providing services must contact the Area Agency on Aging of the Panhandle to obtain information relating to contractor open enrollment, the contracting process, the types of services being considered, and the actual funding available.
